How to Play

Shuffle the deck of cards.

3 players or fewer - Deal each player a hand of 10 cards.

Place the remaining cards face down in the centre of the players.

Players take it in turns to collect 1 card from the centre deck. This begins each player's 'turn'.

With 8 cards in their hand, the player whose turn it is may play a 'set'. A set consists of 1 character card, 1 education level card, and 1 subject card.

Once the player has played any sets they have, they must discard a card, face up in the centre of the players.

Players may collect cards from the discard pile as well as from the main deck.

Players may add a card to a played set if:

- The card does not already form part of the set
- The card matches one of the criteria on the character card
- The player has played at least 1 set

The winner is the first person to discard all of their cards

Teacher's Notes

The optimum number of players is 3. If you choose to have students play in groups of 4 or 5, then the number of cards each student is dealt should be reduced to 7.

The aim of the game is to have students learn a little about careers whilst having fun.

Students should be encouraged to read out loud their character, what they do, and the subjects and qualifications that they need to do their job.

It is helpful to encourage students to read out loud the skills that each subject develops in them.
